## CAMP FEES

Week long camps are **\$140 for members** and **\$155 for non-members** per session. \$20 early bird discount applies when registered before April 1.

## AGE REQUIREMENTS

Children must be within the age range for each camp before camp begins.

## EDUCATORS

Camps are taught by trained and experienced educators. All museum staff have undergone background checks. Meet the Teacher Nights will be held **June 12** and **July 17**, 5:30 - 7p.m. These are free events for camp families, and include play in the museum. **RSVP at [ocm.org](http://ocm.org).**

## SCHEDULING & REFUNDS

Camp space is limited and registration is handled on a first-come, first-served basis. Omaha Children's Museum's summer camps feature engaging curriculum and great instructors who make every day exciting and new. Camps include daily play in the museum, a snack, and a Meet the Teacher Night. Whether your child wants to experiment in our kitchen, train-like an Olympic athlete, if they love making music or playing video games, there is a camp that will match their interests.

## BEFORE & AFTER CARE

During this time, children play games, draw, read or participate in other activities supervised by museum staff. Before and After care is available for all of our summer camp sessions.
